

ORDINANCE NO. 2023-07-01

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TONKAWA, OKLAHOMA APPROVING THAT CERTAIN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF TONKAWA AND KAY COUNTY, ENTITLED AMBULANCE SERVICE AGREEMENT; AND AMENDING THE TONKAWA MUNICIPAL CODE TO ADD SECTION 13-609 TO CHAPTER 13, ARTICLE 6, REPEALING ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Tonkawa, has previously resolved to participate in Kay County Ambulance/Fire Department sales tax initiative that was passed by a vote of the citizens of Kay County. and

WHEREAS, the City of Tonkawa provides emergency medical and ambulances services to the citizens of Tonkawa and to persons outside of the corporate limits of the city of Tonkawa and within the Emergency Medical Service Area as assigned by the Emergency Medical Division of the Oklahoma Department of Health. and

WHEREAS, as a result of the city's desire to participate in said Kay County Ambulance/Fire Department sales tax and in order to receive the city's share of said sales tax funds collected, which is 1/16th of 1/3 of 1%, it is necessary to enter into an Agreement with Kay County, Oklahoma. and

WHEREAS, The City of Tonkawa desires to enter into that certain Ambulance Service Agreement between the City of Tonkawa and Kay County, Oklahoma dated June 20, 2023.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDANED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF NEWKIRK, Oklahoma:

Chapter 13, Article 6, of the TONKAWA MUNICIPAL CODE, 2021, shall be amended to add, Section 13-609 and shall read as follows:

SECTION 13-609 AMBULANCE SERVICE AGREEMENT:

The City and Kay County, Oklahoma have entered into that certain "Ambulance Service Agreement" dated June 20, 2023, in order to receive the City's share of sales tax funds collected by Kay County pursuant to the Ambulance/Fire Department sales tax that was approved by the citizens of Kay County, Oklahoma and became effective April 1, 2023. As part of said Agreement, the City shall perform those "Responsibilities," as stated in said Agreement.

All ordinances or parts thereof that are in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance shall be and the same hereby are, repealed.

The provisions of the Ordinance are severable, and if any part or provision hereof shall be adjudged invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such adjudication shall not affect or impair any or the remaining parts or provisions hereof.


